

Riverside Park, one of the premier community parks in east central Wisconsin, stretches some 3,700 feet along the east bank of the Fox River in the northern portion of the city. During your stay, feel free to explore some of the numerous amenities available to visitors. Facilities include two softball and one youth baseball diamond, over 2,000 feet of sea wall with boat moorings; a double boat launch; state-of-the-art basketball courts with glass backboards; 8 lighted horse-shoe courts; five children's playground areas; and Clark School Museum.
