- A map or sketch (which must either be to scale or have sufficient dimensional markings to provide the necessary information) of the property or properties upon which chickens will be kept, with the proposed improvements, that shows all of the following:
 - Location and size of houses and other structures on the property
 - Identification of all lot lines, including the identification of each separate lot affected
 - Location, size and type of all structures and containment areas for the chickens (i.e. coop, pen and fencing for run)
 - Identification of distances of chicken enclosures from all structures (including, but not limited to, houses on adjacent properties), and lot lines.
