It is a checkered eye and states that the person wearing it has low vision which will help alert business people that additional help is needed. He will possibly order a supply of buttons/pins and will work with the Lions Club on this.

The financial reports were approved on a motion by Pelchat/N Trochinski. The motion passed by voice vote.

Members received a copy of an email on proposed tax cuts and more information on this was passed out at the meeting.

The Thanksgiving meal was attended by 110 people plus the deliveries. There was a packed house for speaker, Jerry Apps. The speaker was funded by Berlin Library.

John Krings is currently working on the railing for the side entrance to the center.

New flooring is being looked at for four different areas of the center.

The Ladies Christmas Tea will be held on Tuesday, December 12th at 2 PM. We have received at grant from Thrivent which will be used for expenses. Another part of the grant is being used for 13 people who have lost a spouse or do not get out of the house. They are given credit for \$20 to cover 5 meals at the center to try to get them out among other people.

The Senior Center Christmas dinner will be held at noon on Thursday, December 20th.

2018 trip brochures were available for members to take with them.

Joy will be retiring. She would like to be done by the end of the year but she will stay on until February if needed to train her replacement. Karen is working with Jodie to advertise for Joy's replacement.
