



<u>BACKGROUND:</u> The position of Building Inspector is appointed annually by the Mayor with Council approval at the annual Organizational Meeting. - Provide office hours Monday & Wednesday, 8:30 a.m. 10:30 a.m., April 1 November 1 and Mondays, 8:30-10:30 a.m., November 2 March 31 or by appointment.
- Issuance of permits, Exhibit "B" Fee Schedule.
- Inspection of construction.
- Responding to property owners' and builders' questions.
- Property maintenance, when requested, at \$60/hour.
- Zoning administration, when requested, at \$60/hour.
- Meeting attendance, when requested, at \$60/hour.

As provided above, we intend to implement a sliding scale reimbursement (as shown on Exhibit "A") from permit fee proceeds to minimize the out of pocket costs by City residents and taxpayers. In addition to responsibilities associated with building inspection and zoning administration, we would like to highlight below some of the advantages of working with our firm:
