- Section 4. The City Plan Commission has held at least one public hearing on the subject matter of this ordinance on November 28, 2017, in compliance with the requirements of section 66.1001(4)(d) of the Wisconsin Statues.
- Section 5. The Common Council of the City of Berlin, Wisconsin, does, by enactment of this ordinance, formally adopt the document entitles, "City of Berlin Comprehensive Plan, and Revised November 29, 2011 through November 28, 2017, Public Hearing November 28, 2017, City Council Approved December 12th, 2017" pursuant to section 66.1001(4)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes.
- **Section 6.** This ordinance shall be codified and numbered in the discretion of the City of the City codifier, subject to final approval by the Common Council.


