Our Drivers are happy to assist with loading and unloading of elderly or disabled passengers, and providing assistance in carrying parcels or personal affects between the vehicle and the entrance to business and home. For insurance reasons we cannot go inside your home, but we can help from your front door to ours.



Please remember that we are a “Shared-Ride Taxi” service. Therefore, you must allow adequate travel time to and from appointments and allow for short delays, as others may be scheduled to ride with you. Every attempt will be made to get you to your destination on time. Please see your driver for taxi rules & regulations or visit www.cityofberlin.net for more information.

ADDITIONAL FARES

All trips outside of the city limits of Berlin are subject to an additional charge of \$1.50/mile.

Trips to Green Lake are \$15/rider plus the Base Fare.



HANDICAP ACCESSIBILITY

Specialized service is available for disabled and elderly individuals who require door to door assistance from the shared ride operator. Notice must be given when making reservations if passenger is in a wheelchair or requires special door to door assistance. Additional time is required to load and unload wheelchair passengers. Please note clients must be dressed and ready to go when driver arrives.

Passenger safety is our number one priority. We are safe while on the road and our drivers will make sure you get inside safely too!



HELPFUL

Please let us know if you need or desire assistance. Many customers do not want or need assistance, so we will assume curb-to-curb service unless you tell us you need otherwise.
