- Update on Street Projects – Malnory stated that the watermain from Cumberland to Park is in and that all we have left to do is 2 tie ins, a couple of days for the sanitary sewer and then to Ripon Road, which will take a couple of days and then the Utility work will be done.
- Update on Generator at WWTP – Malnory stated that the exhaust has been hooked up and ready to go. We are ready for Cummins to come in to do the startup.
- PFA's and Pharmaceuticals – PFA's are manmade chemicals that buildup and don't go away. The DNR wants Treatment Plants to test for it because they could be getting into the ground water. We do have something in our ordinances already, but we might need to update.

The next meeting was scheduled for September 25, 2019.

Erdmann moved to adjourn. Youngbauer seconded the motion which carried by voice vote.
