**Cruise back in time and explore the Upper Mississippi with us! The La Crosse Queen is a modern -day replica of the grand river boats that plied the Mississippi River in the early 1900s. In keeping with early traditions, she was built with sternwheels that are her only means of propulsion.**

**The Queen has a split stern-wheel, this is in contrast to most Mississippi River paddle wheelers in operation today that have a paddlewheel at the stern of the boat for visual effect, but have traditional screw-type engines hidden for their real means of propulsion.**



**Lacrosse has a rich history on the Mississippi of trading and beauty. We'll hear about some of the history of the city and it's buildings , as the Lacrosse County Historical Society takes us around town.**
