

Press Release:

Beginning Wednesday March 18, 2020, the Berlin Senior Center will close to the public until further notice. This is based on recommendations from Governor Evers, our local public health authorities and the Center for Disease Control (CDC) for implementing social distancing guidelines to minimize the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak. This closure will be on a temporary basis as a precautionary measure to assist in reducing the spread of COVID-19 and to ensure the health and well-being of our participants.

Meal services offered through the Green Lake County Nutrition Program will continue to home-bound individuals. Meals will also be available for pick-up at the Berlin Senior Center from 11:00 -11:30 am. Individuals requesting meals for pick-up must call 920-361-5422 the day before to sign up.

Transportation Services funded by Grant 85.21 will continue to be available during the regular hours of 8:00 – 10:30am & 1:00 – 4:00pm for essential services including, but not limited to, medical appointments and grocery shopping needs. Any transportation related to social events will not be permitted at this time.
