Our City departments will continue to provide essential services to our residents, but we are limiting public access to our non-essential facilities at this time. Along with the prior suspension of the Berlin Senior Center and Berlin Public Library, public access to Berlin City Hall has now been suspended until further notice.

Please know that all emergency services including Police, Fire, Ambulance, Water & Sewer and Public Works are still taking care of business as usual. There may be some modifications of how service is performed as any unnecessary personal contact will try to be eliminated as we move through this time of the COVID-19 pandemic.
