- Campground opens May 15<sup>th</sup> Closes October 15<sup>th</sup> (weather permitting)
- Fees: \$25.00 per day \$150.00 per week, to be paid on arrival
- Limited number of sites available for reservation. Remaining sites are available on a first come, first served basis. Call for availability.
- Maximum stay per unit is 14 days
- Check out time 12:00 noon, Check in 1:00 PM
- Quiet Hours 10:00 pm (11:00 on Saturday) 8:00 am
- Guests are asked to stay on designated roadway in Camping Area
- Garbage policy is what you take in you take out. We have a dumpster container available.
- Please do not place garbage in fire rings or grills.
- Camper Parking perpendicular to River only.
- Camping in designated sites only
- Two Vehicles per site (1 RV or camping unit)
- Two tent limit allowed per site



- No fires except in designated pits and grills. Fires must be attended to at all times.
- Please help us recycle and place garbage bags in appropriate garbage cans. Glass bottles prohibited.
- Dump Station \$3.00 per use. Free to overnight campers.
- Dump Station water is to be used only for filling your vehicle's water tanks \*Not to be used for vehicle wash, filling jugs to take home, etc.
- All units must have holding tanks. All waste water must be dumped at dump station. Under no circumstances are tanks to be dumped on the ground.
- Pets allowed on 7-foot leash only. Pets shall not be left on campgrounds while owners are away.
- Owners are responsible for cleaning up after pets. Pets not allowed in shelter houses or athletic fields.
- Please do not harm our shrubs or trees in any way. Guests damaging or destroying park property will be expected to make restitution. Chain saws strictly prohibited.
- WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO EVICT, WITHOUT PRIOR NOTICE, ANYONE WHO IN OUR JUDGE-MENT CREATES A DISTURBANCE, OR NUISANCE, OR DELIBERATELY BREAKS ANY OF THE ABOVE RULES. No reimbursement of fees will be made in the event of such eviction.

## **GUIDANCE FOR CAMPGROUNDS TO SLOW THE SPREAD OF COVID-19**

New rules in place due to guidance from the CDC, and Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade & Consumer Protection.

- All campsites are limited to members of a single household or living unit.
- All private gatherings of any number of people is prohibited.
- Campers are encouraged to bring all food and supplies from their home communities to limit shopping outside the campground.
- No visitors are allowed to campsites or campground property.
- Campers shall maintain the 6 feet of social distancing with anyone from different households.
- Children must remain under parental supervision at all times.
- Campers are not permitted to gather with other households, including around a campfire.
- Campground restrooms are emergency use only.
