

ORDINANCE #15-20

AN ORDINANCE TO INSTALL A STOP SIGN ON WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT ROAD
AT KNOPF ROAD

The Common Council of the City of Berlin do ordain as follows:

Sec. 7-391 of the Code of Ordinances shall be amended as follows:

Sec. 70-391. - Stop intersections.

Motor vehicle operators within the city shall be required to stop at the following street intersections:

...

(34) At the intersection of Waste Water Treatment Plant Road and Knopf Road, traffic traveling east on Waste Water Treatment Plant Road must stop before entering Knopf Road.

The Public Works Superintendent is directed and authorized to install official traffic signs at such intersection accordingly.

This ordinance shall take effect the day after publication.

The numeric section numbers and headings herein shall be subject to modification in the discretion of the codifier, and the approval of the city attorney, during codification into the city's current code of ordinances.
