**STORM DAMAGE PICK-UP:** The Director of Public Works will determine if there is a need for brush pick up after a storm.

**OTHER LEAF & BRUSH REMOVAL  
OPTIONS:**

- Request a BRUSH TRUCK for large piles by calling 361-5425. Fees apply.
- *CITY OF BERLIN RESIDENTS ONLY* may drop off leaves, grass, sticks, branches, garden waste and other organic *compostable waste* at the City of Berlin Compost Site located at White Ridge Rd. (Enter Berlin Conservation Club site and take a right at the first driveway.)
- NO GARBAGE, APPLIANCES, ELECTRONICS, FURNITURE OR TIRES. Violators will be fined.
- May-October: First Saturday of each month drop off available at the City Garage from 8 a.m.—noon.

**ELDERLY/PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED  
CURBSIDE PICKUP:**

- Pickup begins first Tuesday in May starting at 6:00 a.m.
  - Grass clippings and leaves are to be in containers or bags that can be easily handled
  - Brush and branches in armful amounts that can be handled without the use of equipment
  - Call City Garage at 361-5425 on Mondays (7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.) to request pickup. DO NOT call City Hall
  - Failure to comply with conditions will result in materials not being picked up

**STUMP REMOVAL**

- Register at City Hall by the first Friday in May
- Only stumps that are in the terrace will be removed
- Cost will be \$100 per stump



**SPRING RUBBISH  
PICKUP**

Pick-up parameters for **garbage** will be limited to a 12'x4'x4' area on the terrace. Place rubbish on terrace no sooner than ONE WEEK before pick up date. The Director of Public Works will be monitoring closely. Violators will be issued citations.

**2021 Spring Rubbish & Brush Pickup  
Schedule**

Weather permitting pickup will begin May 3, 2021 for the following schedule:

**Monday, May 3, 2021** south of Broadway and west of the bridge

**Tuesday, May 4, 2021** north of Broadway and west of the bridge

**Wednesday, May 5, 2021** north of W. Huron, east of the bridge and west of N. Wisconsin Street

**Thursday, May 6, 2021** north of E. Huron and east of N. Wisconsin Street

**Friday, May 7, 2021** south of E. Huron and east of the bridge

**Brush should be piled parallel with the street and cut ends to your right as you face the street.**

## WEEKLY RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE & RECYCLING

The City contracts for weekly garbage collection and single stream recycling with Advanced Disposal. Each residence is allotted one 95 gallon cart for trash and one 65 gallon cart for recycling. Volumes restricted to inside the cart with lids closed. The city is split into two pick-up days as follows:

### Schedule for Residential Garbage & Recycling Pick-Up

**MONDAYS:** Residences west of North Wisconsin Street and south of East Huron Street are serviced.

**THURSDAYS:** Residences east of North Wisconsin Street and north of East Huron Street are serviced.

Carts must be curbside by 7:00 a.m. This is a fully automated service so carts must be placed on the terrace area behind the curb at least three (3) feet apart, as noted on the cans, lids facing the street and handles toward the dwelling.

## WHAT CAN I RECYCLE?

Mix all of the following recyclables in your cart for collection: (*loose; do not tie or bundle paper*)

- Newspaper, magazines & catalogs

- Corrugated cardboard (boxes flattened, no larger than 3'x3')
- Junk mail & envelopes
- Fiberboard (soda and beer boxes, cereal and cracker boxes, etc)
- Phone books
- Paperback books
- Hardcover books (with binding & cover removed)
- Aluminum cans (rinsed)
- Aerosol cans (cap & nozzle removed)
- Glass food & beverage containers (any color & rinsed)
- Plastic narrow-neck bottles marked #1 & #2 (rinsed)



## ELECTRONICS DISPOSAL

The City of Berlin holds an annual e-cycle event where electronics, TVs, cell phones, printers, monitors, cell phones, laptops, computers, etc. can be dropped off.

- Drop off Saturday May 1, 2021 at City Garage, 241 Spring Street
- Hours: 8:00 am to 12:00 noon
- Charge per pound



## APPLIANCE DISPOSAL

Appliances such as freezers, refrigerators, dehumidifiers, microwaves and air conditioning units will be picked up during Spring Rubbish Pick-up week for a **NON-REFUNDABLE \$6.00 fee** per appliance, which is due in advance, payable at the City Clerk's Office.



## HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL

Green Lake County & Waushara County hold annual Clean Sweep Hazardous Waste Collection programs where residents can dispose of hazardous materials such as agricultural chemicals, lawn & garden products, household cleaners, poisons, oil based paints & paint related products, mercury thermometers, rechargeable batteries, fluorescent bulbs, waste oil, antifreeze, pool chemicals, etc.



## YARD WASTE & LEAVES



### SPRING & FALL GRASS & LEAF PICKUP

The City of Berlin Department of Public Works collects loose leaves and grass clippings in the spring and fall of each year for residents.

- Leaves should be placed loose and in the terrace only
- DO NOT include sticks, twigs or branches
- ABSOLUTELY NO GARBAGE, APPLIANCES, FURNITURE, TIRES, ETC

**2021 Spring Leaf Pickup:** Begins the week of April 12—ONE TIME THROUGH THE CITY

**2021 Fall Leaf Pickup:** Approximate dates for Fall collection are from the third Monday in October until all leaves are picked up or weather does not permit.
