

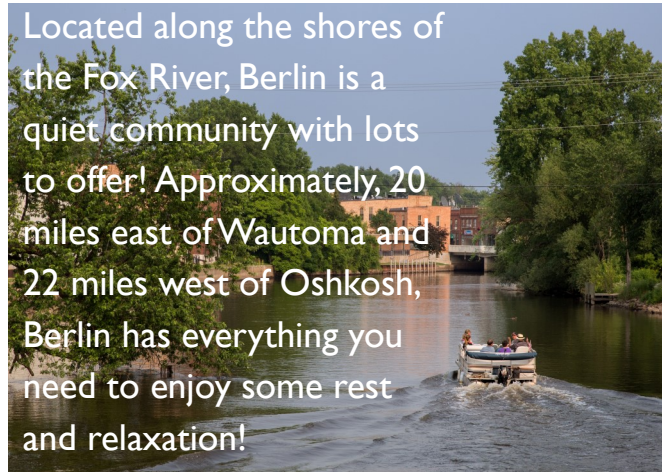
Amenities

Berlin also offers a wide variety of different amenities to enjoy. Throughout the parks, there are 5 volleyball courts, a 9 hole disc golf course with 2 pad placements, and a basketball court. There are also horse shoes, 3 baseball diamonds, and a batting cage. The Mascoutin Valley Trail, which runs 21 miles total, also runs through town. You can access the river by one of the numerous public fishing areas or boat landings. Berlin also has numerous playgrounds and open green space areas with benches for enjoying.

Riverside Park also is home to Veterans Gazebo which has access to electricity. On the other side of town, Nathan Strong Park has a Gazebo available as well with a playground and a port-a-potty.



Parks

Finally, Volunteer Park, located in the middle of downtown, is the perfect spot to take a break while enjoying downtown Berlin.



Camping
