MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into on January 5, 2022, between the City of Berlin, hereafter referred to as the City, and Hawkins Ash CPAs, LLP, hereafter referred to as the Auditor. The parties agree as follows:

Background

The City of Berlin has recognized this property as a recurring nuisance property with violations occurring in 2017, 2019, 2020 and 2021. As a result three assessment letters were issued during the first three quarters of the year, with little response.

At the previous Common Council meeting, neighbors reported on the lack of progress being made on the property and of debris blowing around the front yard and onto neighbor's properties. Council requested the homeowner clean up the outside debris on the property and present a written schedule of repairs to be completed on the property in the future.

Discussion

On December 20, 2021 exterior inspections and communication was made to Jerry Newton at 271 McKittrick Street. On this date, substantial debris was present in both the front and rear yards and the only completed modification have been re-roofing of the existing structure. The following day, the Police Department informed me the debris had been cleaned up in the front yard and none remained except those related to the impending construction in the rear yard. It appears there will be a foundation installed of poured concrete at 4 feet of depth below ground and 8 inches wide. All rotting areas of frame and structure have been ordered to be replaced. All broken windows and their respective framing still need to be removed and replaced. There is still evidence in the breezeway of bird access. The Owner was not able to provide access for an interior inspection, alleging he had lost the key to the front door. The Jerry Newton communicated there will be a follow up inspection with the Building Inspector Monday January 10th.

Building Assessment Progress.

The roof of the homes original construction is steel which appears to be weather tight, but has areas of deterioration which require repair or replacement. – Appears to be fully replaced from outside?

The roof of the addition and the garage is of asphalt shingles and severely deteriorated and requires removal and replacement. – Appears to be fully replaced from outside?

The roof wall junctures are improperly flashed and must be correctly repaired, with all deteriorated and rotten materials removed and replaced. - Appears to be fully repaired from outside?

All deteriorated roof framing members (rafters) and sheathing must be replaced. – Appears to be **fully replaced** from outside, Interior Inspection should grant view of framing stability or lack thereof?

No gutters installed on the home and attached garage have caused severe deterioration to the foundation and supporting structure at its perimeter. All rotten and deteriorated, structural and nonstructural components and or materials are to be removed and replaced. –Through discussion this is been communicated to be a priority after the kitchen is rebuilt, because drainage is pertinent to the long term integrity of the new structure. However, **Not Started.**

Deterioration of structural and nonstructural components have caused uneven settling and damage. All deteriorated and damaged components must be repaired and or replaced. i.e. foundation walls, floor joist, sill and sole plates, studs, wall sheathing, siding, soffit and fascia, all quire repair, removal, and or replacement. — *In progress*, work started on foundation to removed portion and load bearing of connecting points.

Deteriorated, damaged and broken window and door trim, frames, sashes and panels must be removed and replaced. Windows and doors are currently allowing birds and rodents to enter and nest. — **Not Started**. Communicated to be determined spring pending selecting contractors and other workers assistance.

Vegetation in contact with the roof structures must be removed. - Done

Vegetation and soil within 8" of structural and or wood components must be removed. – *In Progress*- at least in addition area, cleared compared to 2020 pictures.

The chimney is improperly flashed and secured and must be corrected - Chimney Removed

There has been substantial improvement of this property from the original ordered repairs, an addition by subtraction of sorts, where the preponderance of the deficient structure, including roof, wall, foundation, and chimney has been removed and the brush/debris on the house and in the yard has been removed. The only exception is the area adjacent to the kitchen section being reconstructed.

Recommendation

Due to the improvements the homeowner has completed over the last month, including the cleaning up of the outside debris, and removing hazardous structures, staff recommends allowing two months for the homeowner to continue his progress on the property, with a status report requested in March.
