### **Keep Important Papers Safe**



You have gone through the trouble of getting all your important papers filled out so where do you keep them? Having them loose in a desk drawer is not a good idea. Putting them in a safety deposit box at your bank is best, it is not always convenient (and sometimes expensive). There are steps you can take to make them easily accessible.

Begin by making copies of all your important documents including your will, financial power of attorney, health care power of attorney, etc. Store the original documents in your safety deposit box at a financial institution or a fire safe container in your home. There are several ways to keep the document copies organized, but a 3-ring binder is handy to keep them all together in one place. Use tab dividers to separate the different types of documents and clear sleeves to hold each document to keep it clean and hold smaller pieces of paper.

Review this binder regularly and update it when necessary, generally when a major life changing event. Make the changes to the originals and then make another copy and update the binder. Creating a binder allows you to review it easily and give you piece of mind that your wishes will be followed when it is needed.
