TEN WARNING SIGNS YOUR LOVED ONE MAY NEED HELP

Changes in physical and mental abilities that may occur with age can be difficult to detect for older adults and their family members and friends. To determine when someone may need help, the following are some warning signs:

- 1. Changes in eating habits resulting in losing weight, having no appetite or missing meals.
- 2. Neglecting personal hygiene including wearing dirty clothes and having body odor, bad breath, neglected nails and teeth or sores on the skin.
- 3. Neglecting their home, with a noticeable change in cleanliness and sanitation.
- 4. Exhibiting inappropriate behavior such as being unusually loud, quiet, paranoid or agitated or making phone calls at all hours.
- 5. Changes in relationship patterns, causing friends and neighbors to express concern.
- 6. Physical problems such as burns or injuries which may result from general weakness, forgetfulness, misuse of alcohol or prescribed medication.
- 7. Decreasing or stopping participation in activities that were once important to them, such as bridge, a book club, dining with friends or attending religious services.
- 8. Exhibiting forgetfulness, unopened mail, piles of newspapers, not filing their prescriptions or missing appointments.
- 9. Mishandling finances such as not paying bills, losing money, paying bills twice or more or hiding money.
- 10. Making unusual purchases such as buying more than one subscription to the same magazine, entering an unusually large number of contests or increase in purchasing from television advertisements.

If you notice any of these, it is important to inform your loved ones' physician of these physical and/or behavioral changes. The Aging & Disability Resource Center can help caregivers get connected to information on programs, services and resources to help enable the older adult to continue living independently in their homes and community.
