SEWER AND WATER COMMISSION MEETING BERLIN, WISCONSIN September 28, 2022

Roethel called the meeting to order at 4:30 P.M. Present – Commissioners Bending, Dewhurst, Roethel, and Youngbauer. Absent – Beard.

Also, present was Samantha Stobbe, Sara Rutkowski, Supt. Malnory, Peggy Labuda, and Jennifer Langham.

The next item on the agenda was public appearances/correspondence. We had no other public appearances or correspondence.

The next item on the agenda was approval of minutes from the August 31, 2022 Meeting. Youngbauer moved to approve the minutes of the August 31, 2022 Meeting. Dewhurst seconded the motion, which was carried by voice vote.
