
Where is Riverside Park Campground?

Directions:

From East: come into Berlin on Hwy 91 go right on Wisconsin St. to Waushara, left on Waushara. Waushara dead ends into campground.

From North or West: Come in on Hwy 91 or Broadway and make a left onto Wisconsin and then a left on Waushara.

From South: Follow Hwy 49 South into Berlin. Make left onto Huron St. Right onto Wisconsin and then a left onto Waushara St.

At 38 acres. River Side Park serves as Berlin's primary park facility. The park is heavily used by boaters, fishermen, campers, picnickers, athletes, and provides access to the Fox River. It accommodates softball & volleyball leagues, youth programs, and hosts a number of community events and festivals. Facilities include two lighted softball diamonds and an unlighted youth baseball diamond; volleyball courts; over 2,000 feet of sea wall with boat moorings; a double boat launch: state-of-the-art basket-ball courts with glass backboards; 8 lighted horseshoe courts; 22 - unit RV camping area with electric hookups and fire pits as well as showers and restrooms within the campground, shoreline moorings, water supply, and dump station; three large shelter houses with restrooms and electricity; five children's playground areas; and Clark School Museum. We hope you enjoy your stay at River Side Park!

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- ♦ Campground opens May 15th Closes
 October 15th (weather permitting)
- ♦ Fees: \$30.00 per day \$180.00 per week, to be paid on arrival
- 22 tent and RV sites with 20/30 amp service of which 6 sites that enjoy 50 amp service
- Limited number of sites available for reservation. Remaining sites are available on a first come, first served basis. Please call for availability.
- Maximum stay per unit is 14 days. Then campers must leave campground for a minimum of 24 hours
- ♦ Check out time 12:00, Check in 1:00 PM
- ♦ Visitation hours 7:00 am 11:00 pm
- Quiet Hours 10:00 pm to 8am daily with the exception of Saturday 11pm to 8a
- Guests are asked to stay on designated roadway in Camping Area
- Garbage policy is what you take in you take out. We have a dumpster container available.
- Do not place garbage in fire rings or grills.
- ♦ Campers Must Park perpendicular to River
- Camping in designated sites only
- Two Vehicles per site (1 RV or camping unit)
- ♦ Two tent limit allowed per site
- No external wood can be brought into the Berlin Campgrounds.
- No fires except in designated pits and grills.

- Fires must be attended at all times.
- Glass bottles prohibited.
- Dump Station water is to be used only for filling your vehicle's water tanks Not to be used for vehicle wash, filling jugs to take home, etc.
- All units must have holding tanks. All waste water must be dumped at dump station. Under no circumstances are tanks to be dumped on the ground.
- Pets allowed on 7-foot leash only. Pets shall not be left on campgrounds while owners are away.
- Owners are responsible for cleaning up after pets.
- Pets not allowed in shelter houses or athletic fields.
- Do not harm our shrubs or trees in any way. Guests damaging or destroying park property will be expected to make restitution. Chain saws strictly prohibited.

WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO EVICT, WITHOUT PRIOR NOTICE, ANYONE WHO IN OUR JUDGEMENT CREATES A DISTURBANCE, NUISANCE, OR DELIBERATELY BREAKS ANY OF THE ABOVE RULES.

No reimbursement of fees will be made in the event of such eviction.
