Berlin's City Council approved new traffic stops in the Community. Beginning Monday, April 10<sup>th</sup>, there will be twenty (20) intersection changes implemented. Most are minor, adding a stop sign where people would yield already at an uncontrolled intersection. However, there are two locations in the community that will have major intersection changes. A map will be available on the City's Facebook page and city's website at [www.cityofberlin.net](http://www.cityofberlin.net) that will pinpoint all the intersection changes.

On the corner of Bates St, East Moore St and Sumner St, what is currently a two-way stop will become a four-way stop. On the corner of Leffert St, June St, and Ripon St, what is a yield sign will become a stop sign at the three-road intersection.

There will be flags placed on all new signs in the community. Drivers are advised to be extra alert when driving in the community as to prevent any accidents.
