The Friends of the Berlin Senior Center purchased a milk cooler for the Center

Our transportation program has driven over 13,500 miles and transported over 300 people.

The nutrition program terved approximately 14,000 between carry outs, dine ins and homebound. On average, that is 1,200 meals a month.

On the activities side, we served approximately 5,400 which, on average is, 450 people per month.

We were a recipient of the Websters Grant which allowed us to find the instillation and start up of the snack bar.

We went on 9 different day trips totaling over 1, 580 miles. We visited the Fireside, Door County, Appleton Performing Arts Center, the Brewers and the Timber Rattlers.
