Park Summer Grounds Work

Primary Function:

Park summer grounds workers assist in the maintenance of the Parks, Aquatic facilities, Grounds, and Special Events. Promote positive relations to the community and park patrons.

Duties/Responsibilities (include but are not limited to):

- General sanitation: Garbage pickup, bathroom and Shelter House cleaning, graffiti removal, etc.
- Lawn and tree care. Including watering, mowing, push mowing, weed whipping, trimming, pruning, weeding, etc.
- General maintenance on park buildings and structures. Including sanding, painting, changing light bulbs, replacing boards on walkway, etc.
- Some weekend work, to aid in preparation for Shelter rentals
- Athletic field preparation

Qualifications:

- 18 years or older is desired, but not required (must be 18 to drive City vehicles)
- Must possess a valid WI drivers license
- Ability to lift objects up to 75 lbs without assistance (garbage cans, benches, water buckets, etc.)
- Ability to read and comprehend instructions
- Ability to work on your own, or as a team with others
- Ability to reach, grasp, and hold items (weed whips, hoses, pruners, wrenches, etc.)

Skills and Knowledge:

General knowledge of basic hand tools and lawn care equipment such as weed whips, leaf blowers, push mowers, etc. is a plus. Demonstrate sound judgement, initiative, enthusiasm, resourcefulness, and dedication to serve the public in a positive manner.
