Please join us for a public involvement meeting to discuss pavement and curb ramp improvements on WIS 91 from WIS 49 South to the Berlin City Limits in Berlin, in Green Lake County.

The meeting is scheduled for Thursday, June 19, 2025 starting at 5:00 pm at Berlin High School, 222 Memorial Drive, Berlin, WI 54923. Use the southside doors entering into the high school commons. A brief presentation is scheduled to begin at 5:15 pm. The remainder of the meeting will follow an open house format.

The objective of the meeting is to gather your input regarding the proposed improvements and traffic management strategies during construction. The improvement project is currently scheduled to be constructed in 2029.

The project will address pavement and curb ramp deficiencies on WIS 91.

- · The existing pavement is showing signs of deterioration.
- Some existing curb ramps do not meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

Proposed improvements include:

- Replacing the pavement on WIS 91 with asphalt pavement.
- Upgrading existing curb ramps to meet current ADA standards.
- · Updating pavement markings and on-street parking.

WIS 91 will be closed and detoured throughout construction. Traffic will be delayed due to the detour route of WIS 91. The detour route is anticipated to use WIS 49-WIS 21-WIS 116 for regional traffic. It is anticipated that local traffic will take advantage of local alternate routes that will minimize the delay. Access to residences and businesses will be maintained.

New right of way or temporary easements will be required to accommodate the curb ramp upgrades.

Your comments assist us in developing a project that will serve the needs of the traveling public as well as the needs of the local community. Your input is welcome and appreciated throughout the design process so please share your input by **July 11, 2025**.

We look forward to working with you on this important transportation investment.
