

Where is Berlin, Wisconsin?



Nestled along the shore of the Fox River is your opportunity to escape the pressures of every day life and return to a simpler time and place. Berlin is located a mere 20 miles west of Oshkosh. With a population of 5,300 residents.

In addition to **Riverside Park** you will find:

- **Longcroft Park** that is located on the west side of the river just off the downtown area and includes 900 ft of shoreline with several fishing stations, a playground, a paved walkway with many native plants to enjoy, and a small boat launch.
- **Berlin Locks** is another favorite spot for many local anglers. The WI DNR owns 62 acres of land adjacent to the Fox River and former lock site south of the city. Facilities include two boat launches with parking (one above and one below the dam), a handicapped accessible fishing pier, and a restroom facility .

Having been placed in the National Register of Historic Places, **Berlin's Nathan Strong Park** has many outstanding Victorian homes nearby; so take a walk and enjoy outside viewing of these beautiful homes.

Enjoy your stay, and be sure to take in all we have to offer whether it is a ball game in the evening, boating and fishing on the Fox River, or a leisurely afternoon in historic downtown Berlin.



Where is the Riverside Park Campground?

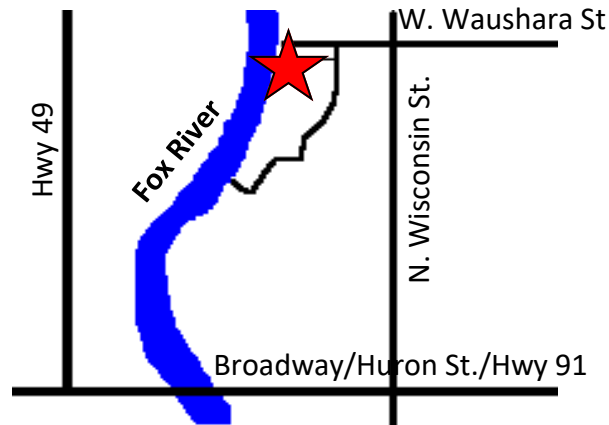
Directions:

From Oshkosh: come into Berlin on Hwy91/ Broadway, go north on N. Wisconsin St., then west on W. Waushara St. which dead ends into the campground.

From the North: come into Berlin on Hwy 49, then east on Broadway, go north on N. Wisconsin St, then west on W. Waushara St. which dead ends into the campground.

From the South: come into Berlin on Hwy 49, turn east onto Huron St., turn north onto N. Wisconsin St., then east on W. Waushara St. which dead ends into the campground.

From the East: come into Berlin on Cty F/Broadway, turn north onto N. Wisconsin St., then east on W. Waushara St. which dead ends into the campground.

WELCOME TO BERLIN!

At 38 acres, Riverside Park serves as Berlin's most active park. The park is used by fishermen, campers, picnickers, athletes, and boaters as it provides access to the Fox River. Facilities include two lit softball diamonds and an unlit youth baseball diamond, volleyball courts, basketball courts, horseshoe pits, a frisbee golf course, over 2,000 feet of sea wall with boat moorings, a boat launch, and playground areas, which accommodates softball & volleyball leagues, and hosts a number of community events and festivals. Also, a 22-site campground along the river complete with electric hookups, fire pits, showers, restrooms, water supply, and dump station. Plus, three large shelter houses with restrooms and electricity, and Clark School Museum. We hope you enjoy your stay at Riverside Park! Call the facilities office to ask about rentals of the campground, ball diamonds and shelter houses.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- ◇ Campground is open from May 15th - October 15th (weather permitting).
- ◇ Fees: \$30.00 per day or \$180.00 per week (7 nights), to be paid on arrival.
- ◇ 22 tent and RV sites all with 20/30 amp service, and 6 sites with 50 amp service.
- ◇ Limited number of sites available for reservation. Remaining sites are available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Please call for availability.
- ◇ Maximum stay per unit is 14 days. Then campers must leave the campground for a minimum of 48 hours.
- ◇ Check in is 1:00 pm, check out is 12:00 pm.
- ◇ Visitation hours are 7:00 am – 11:00 pm.
- ◇ Quiet Hours are 10:00 pm to 8am daily with the exception of Saturday which is 11pm to 8am.
- ◇ Guests are asked to stay on designated roadway in camping area.
- ◇ Garbage policy is - what you take in, you take out. We have a dumpster container available.
- ◇ Do not place garbage in fire rings or grills.
- ◇ Campers must park perpendicular to river.
- ◇ Camping in designated sites only.
- ◇ Two vehicles per site.
- ◇ Two tent limit allowed per site.
- ◇ No external wood can be brought in.
- ◇ No fires except in designated pits and grills.

CONTINUED...

- ◇ Fires must be attended to at all times
- ◇ Glass bottles prohibited.
- ◇ Dump station water is to be used only for filling your vehicle's water tanks, not to be used for vehicle wash, filling jugs to take home, etc.
- ◇ All units must have holding tanks. **All waste water** must be dumped at dump station. Under no circumstances are tanks to be dumped on the ground.
- ◇ Pets allowed on 7-foot leash only. Pets shall not be left on campgrounds while owners are away.
- ◇ Owners are responsible for cleaning up after pets.
- ◇ Pets are not allowed in shelter houses or athletic fields.
- ◇ Do not harm our shrubs or trees in any way. Guests damaging or destroying park property will be expected to make restitution. Chain saws strictly prohibited.

WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO EVICT, WITHOUT PRIOR NOTICE, ANYONE WHO IN OUR JUDGMENT CREATES A DISTURBANCE, NUISANCE, OR DELIBERATELY BREAKS ANY OF THE ABOVE RULES.

No reimbursement of fees will be made in the event of such eviction.
