The City of Berlin prohibits open burning within the city limits with the exception of the following:

1. Cooking Fires
2. Outdoor fireplaces
3. Leaves, grass, and brush (Must have Fire Department Burning Permit)

COOKING FIRES

1. All cooking fires are to be in a UL or FM listed outdoor cooking appliance (i.e. charcoal grills, propane grills, etc.)
2. All cooking fires are to be extinguished after cooking is completed.
3. All cooking fires are to be used in a safe manner.
4. A competent person shall continually attend all cooking fires. The person shall have readily available, approved extinguishing equipment (i.e. fire extinguisher, garden hose connected to water supply).

OUTDOOR FIREPLACES

1. The fireplaces are to be used in a safe manner and in accordance with manufacture's instructions. The creation of excessive smoke is prohibited and only dry wood is to be burnt. Paper, leaves, trash, etc., are also prohibited.
2. The outdoor fireplace shall be complete with a burn pan, lid, and a fire screen all the way around the device. This device shall be used in a safe manner.
3. A competent person shall continually attend all fires. The person shall have readily available, approved extinguishing equipment (i.e. fire extinguisher, garden hose connected to water supply).
