

PARKS IN BERLIN

Nestled along the shore of the Fox River is your opportunity to escape the pressures of every day life and return to a simpler time and place. Berlin is located a mere 20 miles west of Oshkosh, with a population of 5,500 residents.

In addition to Riverside Park you will find:

- **Longcroft Park** that is located on the west side of the river just off the downtown area and includes 900 ft of shoreline with several fishing stations, a playground, a paved walkway with many native plants to enjoy, and a small boat launch.

- **Berlin Locks** is another favorite spot for many local anglers. The WI DNR owns 62 acres of land adjacent to the Fox River and former lock site south of the city. Facilities include two boat launches with parking (one above and one below the dam), a handicapped accessible fishing pier, and a restroom facility .

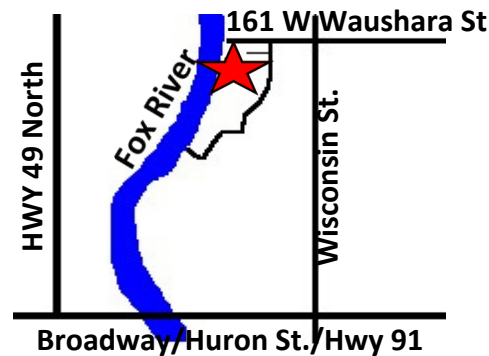
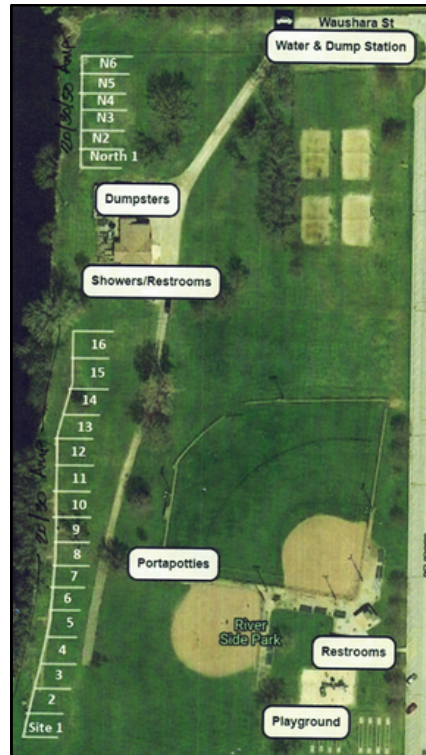

WELCOME TO RIVERSIDE CAMPGROUND!

Riverside Park, one of the premier community parks in east central Wisconsin, stretches approximately 3,700 feet along the east bank of the Fox River in the northern portion of the city. At 38 acres, Riverside park is Berlin's largest park facility. The park is used by boaters, fishermen, campers, picnickers, and athletes and provides access to the Fox River for boating in the summer and snowmobiling during the winter months. Riverside Park hosts a number of community events and festivals.

Facilities at Riverside Park include lighted softball diamonds and an unlit youth baseball diamond each improved with electronic scoreboards and bleachers, a concession stand, five volleyball courts, a 9-hole disc golf course, over 2,000 feet of sea wall with boat moorings, boat launch, basketball courts, horseshoe courts, three large shelter houses with restrooms, electricity and parking, 5 children's playground areas, flower beds, and the Clark School Museum which is a state historical marker.

Prices:

Camping: \$30 per night

\$180 per week/7 nights

Wood: \$5 per 8 pieces

TRANSPORT OF FIREWOOD IS PROHIBITED

Dump Station: \$10 per use for public

(Free for overnight Riverside Campers)

Showers: \$0.50 per minute

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Campground is open May 15th - October 15th (weather permitting)
- Fees: \$30 per day/\$180 per week (7 nights) to be paid upon arrival
- 22 tent and RV sites have 20/30 amp service; 6 of those also have 50 amp service
- Maximum stay per unit is 14 days. Then campers must leave campground for a minimum of 48 hours
- Check in time is 1:00 PM, Check out time is 12:00 PM
- Visitation hours 7:00 AM – 11:00 PM
- Quiet Hours 10:00 PM to 8 AM daily with the exception of Saturday 11 PM to 8 AM
- Guests are asked to stay on designated roadway in camping area
- Garbage policy is - what you bring in, you take out. There is a dumpster container available to dispose of waste
- Do not place garbage in fire rings or grills.
- Campers must park perpendicular to the river
- Camping in designated sites only
- Maximum of two vehicles per site
- One RV or camping unit or two tent limit allowed per site

WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO EVICT, WITHOUT PRIOR NOTICE, ANYONE WHO IN OUR JUDGEMENT CREATES A DISTURBANCE, NUISANCE, OR DELIBERATELY BREAKS ANY OF THE ABOVE RULES.

No reimbursement of fees will be made in the event of such eviction.

CONTINUED...

- No external wood can be brought into the Berlin campgrounds
- No fires except in designated pits and grills
- Fires must be attended to at all times
- Glass bottles prohibited
- Dump station water is to be used only for filling your vehicle's water tanks. Not to be used for vehicle wash, filling jugs to take home, etc.
- All units must have holding tanks. All waste water must be dumped at dump station. Under no circumstances are tanks to be dumped on the ground
- Pets allowed on 7-foot leash only. Pets shall not be left on campgrounds while owners are away
- Owners are responsible for cleaning up after pets
- Pets not allowed in shelter houses or athletic fields
- Do not harm the shrubs or trees in any way. Guests damaging or destroying park property will be expected to make restitution. Chain saws strictly prohibited.
- Cancellation policies apply

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
